I. Overview

As part of the university's on-going assessment initiatives, the Department of Institutional Research and Assessment launched the 2015 Alumni Survey to solicit alumni's opinion about their undergraduate education and employability since their graduation. The survey was targeted to alumni who graduated during the past five years (from 2010-2011 to 2014-2015). Of the 7,834 invited to participate in the online based survey 516 responded yielding a response rate of 7%.

To be able to make valid interpretations with a 95% level of confidence, the confidence interval is 4%. The confidence interval (also called margin of error) is the plus or minus figure by which you can be sure the total population would have chosen the response rate reflected by the sample. For example, referring to the question: Is your current job related to your undergraduate field of study? 80% students responded "Yes". Given that the confidence interval is 4%, one can be 95% confident that the response rate for the total student population would lie in the interval of 76% (80%-4%) to 84% (80%+4%) for the option "Yes".


The 516 respondents are mainly characterized as per the below:

- 58% are graduates from the Beirut campus, 42% from the Byblos campus
- 56% are females, 44% are males
- 15% graduated from the School of Architecture & Design, 26% from the School of Arts & Sciences, 36% from the Adnan Kassar School of Business, 16% from the School of Engineering, 3% from the Alice Ramez Chagoury School of Nursing, and 4% from the School of Pharmacy
- 34% graduated with a BS in Business, 6% with a BE in Mechanical Engineering, 5% with a Bachelor of Architecture, 5% with a BE in Civil Engineering, 4% with a BA in Communication Arts and 4% with a BS in Biology in addition to other undergraduate degrees offered at LAU
- 4% graduated before 3 months of the survey's fill out period, 25% graduated before 3-6 months, 7% before a period between 6 months and 1 year, 25% before a period between 1 year and 2 years and 38% before a period that exceeds 2 years

The major findings of the survey can be summarized as follows:

- 62% reported to be employed, 16% were unemployed but have been employed at least once since graduating from LAU while 23% have never been employed.
- 28% of the respondents have either earned or are currently enrolled in a graduate program while another 4% have either earned or are currently enrolled in a doctoral program. In addition, 20% have either earned or are currently enrolled in another undergraduate degree program.
- 36% have pursued or are currently pursuing professional certifications.
- While completing their undergraduate degree, 76% had an internship experience. Of those who did, 61% rated the internship experience to be either excellent or very good while 24% rated it as good and 8% as average. Only 8% rated the internship experience to be below average.
- Of those who had an internship experience, 36% were offered a full-time job by the company.

- Of the respondents who are currently employed or have been employed at least once, 40% stayed in their first job for a period that is less than one year. 25% reported to have stayed for 1 year, 22% for 2 years, 6% for 3 years while 8% stayed for a period that exceeds 3 years.
- 80% of the respondents who are currently enrolled, reported that their job was related to their undergraduate field of study.
- If they had the chance to start again, 70% would pursue the same undergraduate degree again.
- 68% believed that they were sufficiently prepared at LAU to obtain the entry-level job they wanted
- 44% consider the job preparation they received at LAU to be better than other graduates from similar programs at other colleges and universities. 27% considered the preparation to be about the same as other graduates whereas 13% believed it was worse. 16% were not able to decide.
- Based on their LAU experience between 90% and 100% agreed¹ that they: (1) have good oral and written communication skills, (2) were well prepared to work in a team and (3) are committed to lifelong learning, and (4) are aware of ethical issues inherent in their discipline. Similarly between 80% and 89% agreed that they: (1) are aware of cultural, social, and legal issues inherent in their discipline, (2) are equipped with a solid theoretical background that they find useful at work or in their post bachelor education and (3) are prepared for their careers, locally and/or abroad, with a broad knowledge of in their field. In addition, 74% agreed that they are equipped with good technical skills that they use extensively at work. The above findings are summarized in the graph below:








