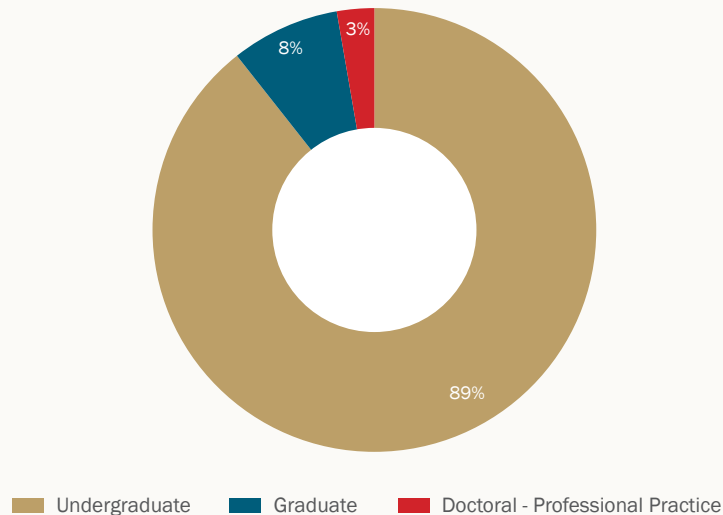

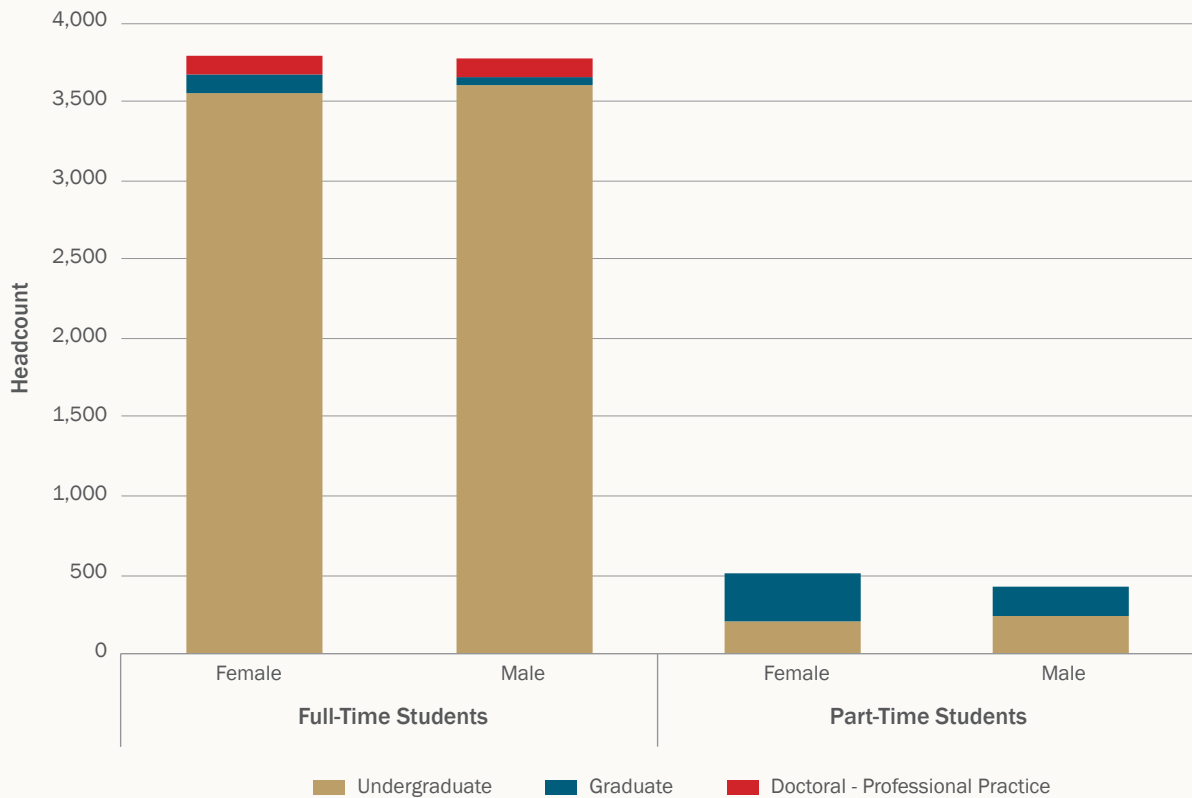

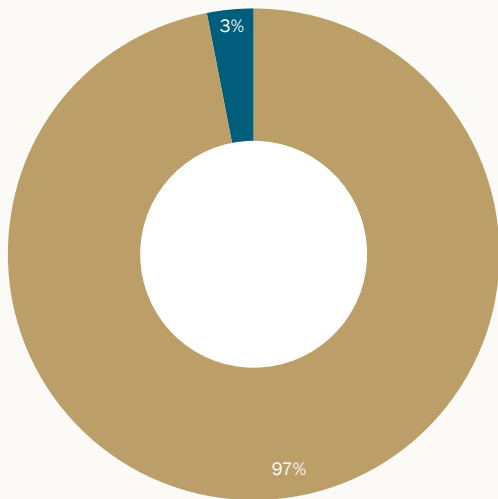

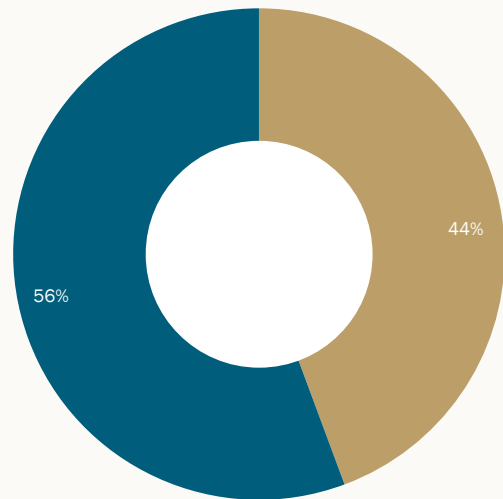

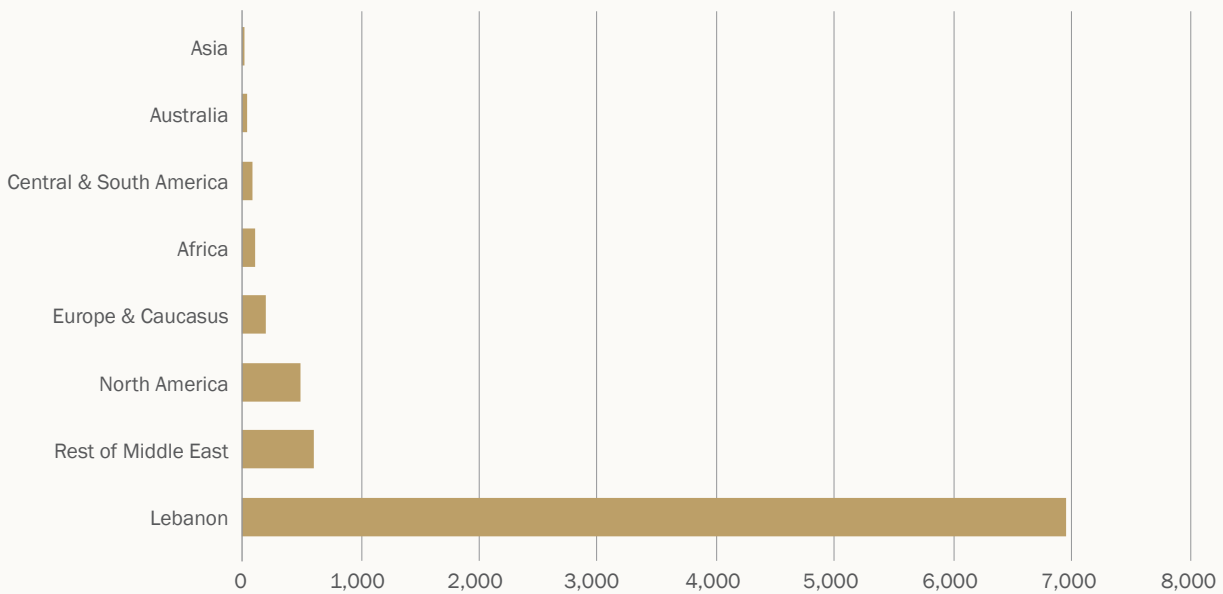

ENROLLMENT BY PLACE OF ORIGIN



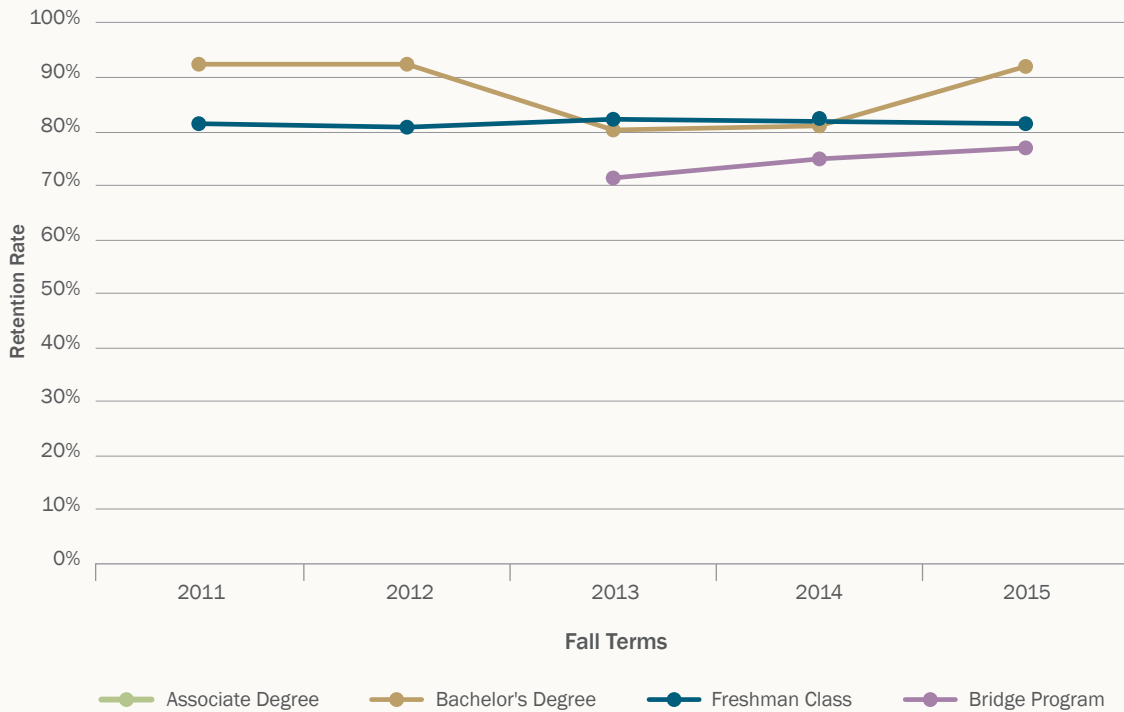

## RETENTION RATES: FIRST-TIME STUDENTS

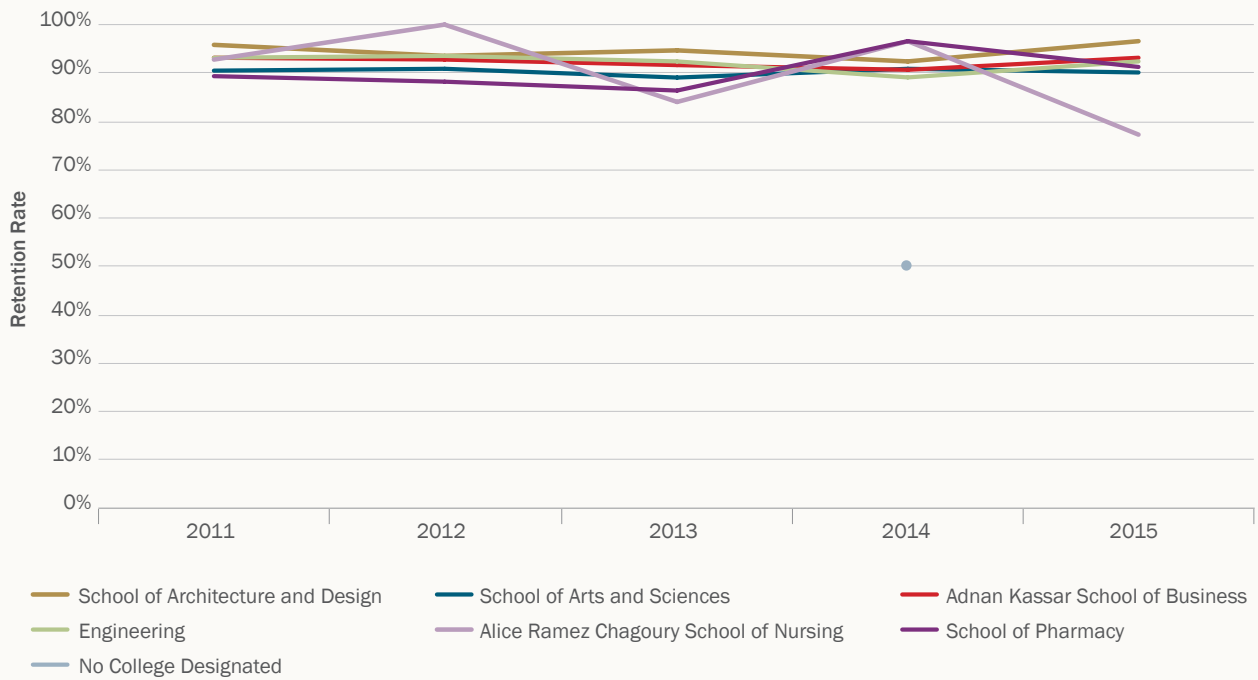

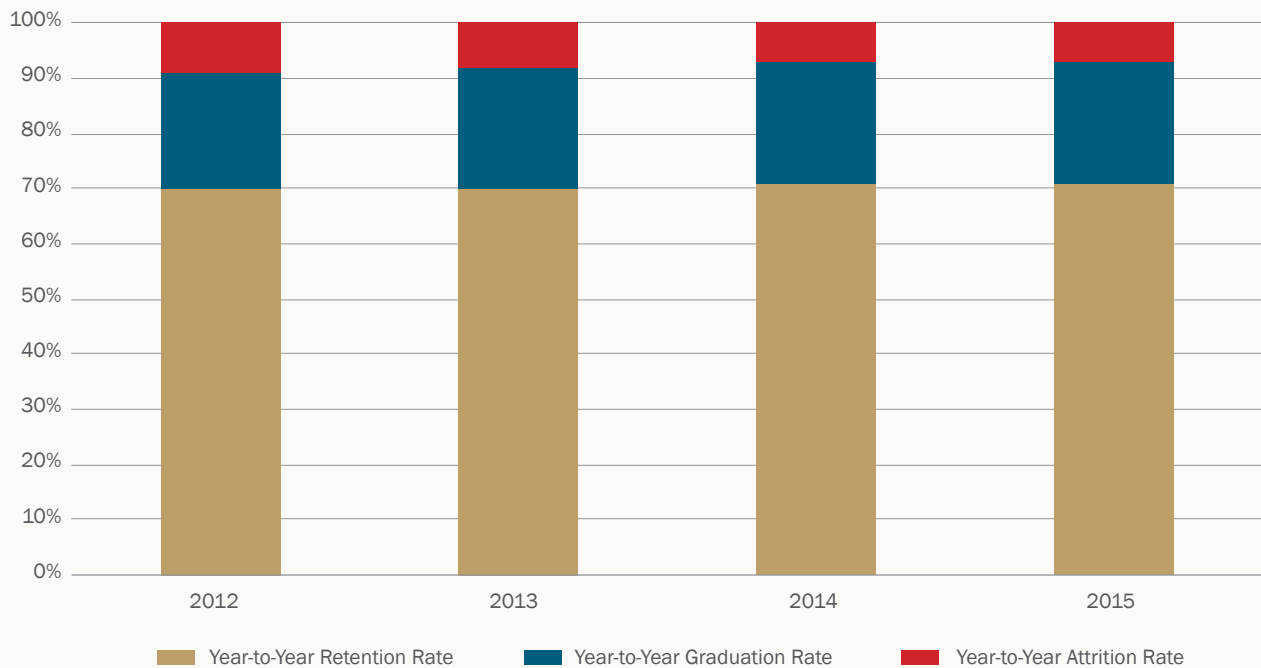
