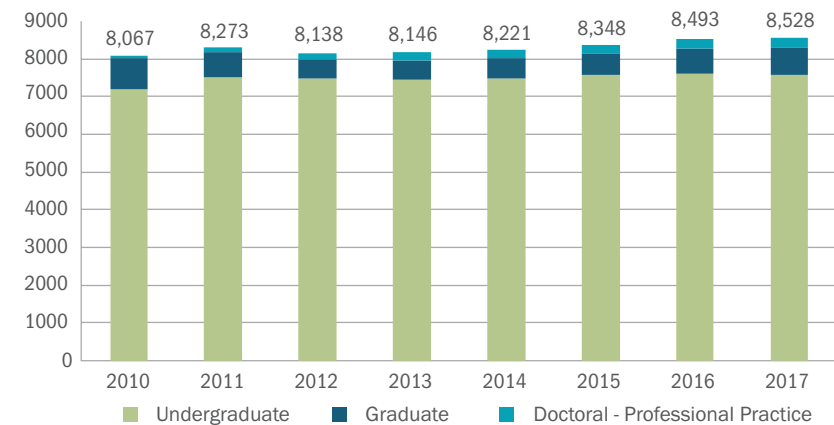

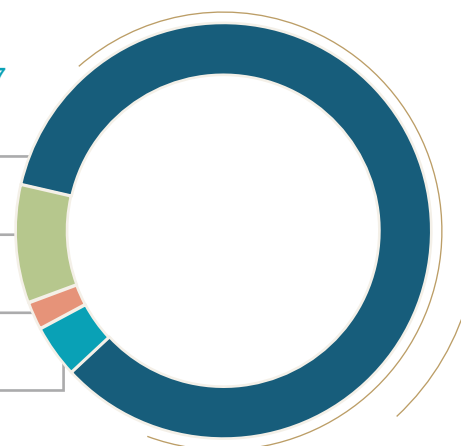

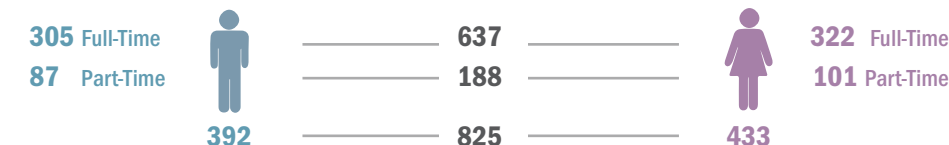

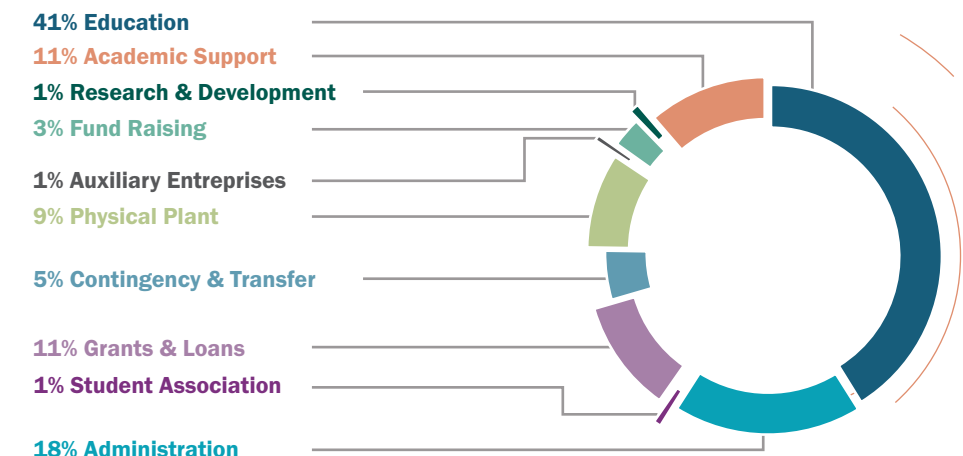


LIBRARY COLLECTIONS (2016-2017)



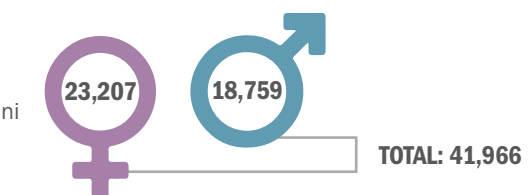
